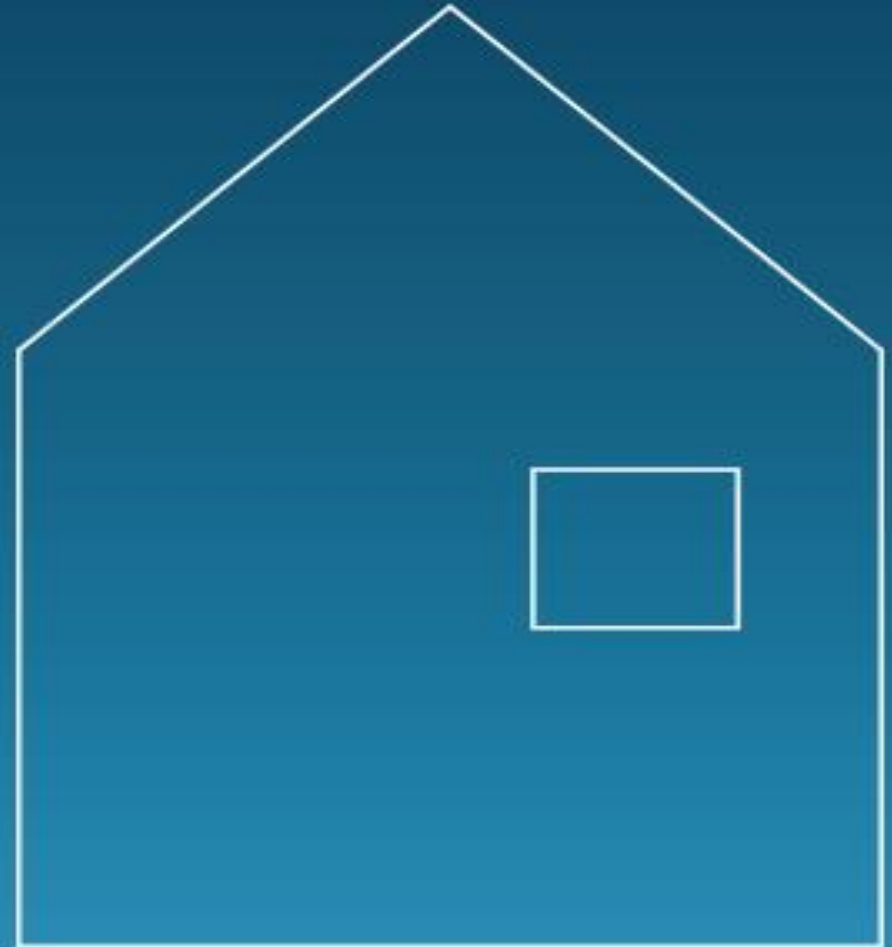
Housing service



Housing service

Aarhus University is not a residential university, which means that the university does not own any student dormitories or other housing facilities.

AU Housing has agreements with different student housing organisations and private property owners throughout Aarhus, and we can therefore offer housing service.

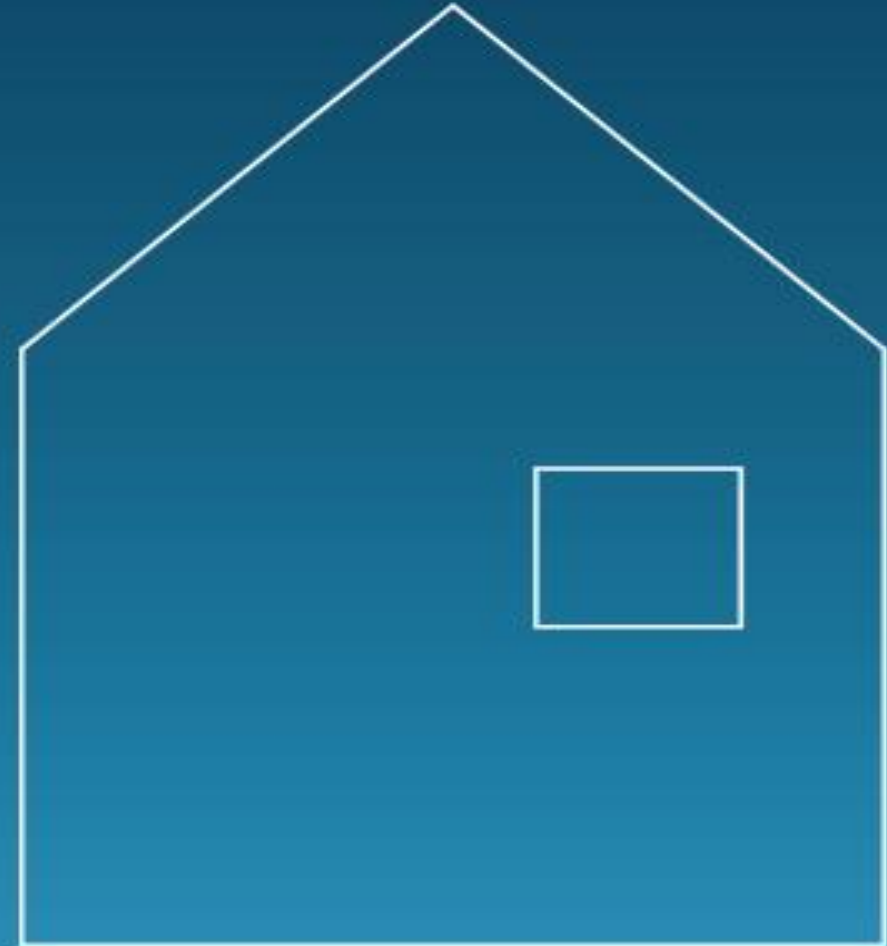


Housing options:

- Room in a student dormitory
- Studio in a student dormitory*
- Room in a shared house

*Please note that studios have a higher price than the other housing types. You can request a studio, but unfortunately, we cannot guarantee that you will be offered one.

Housing periods and prices

Suitable for	Housing period	Price per room*	Price per studio*
Term 1 students	1 July - 28 July 2026	4.300 DKK	5.200 DKK
Term 2 students	15 July - 15 August 2026	4.300 DKK	5.200 DKK
Term 1 + 2 students	1 July - 15 August 2025	5.900 DKK	7.250 DKK

Application procedure

1. Read all relevant information on the website
2. Get accepted for an AU Summer University course
 - I. Follow the application guide in the acceptance letter
 - II. Access the housing application portal via the link in the acceptance letter
3. Apply before the housing deadlines:
 - 1st round: Thursday 16 April 2026 at 12 noon CEST
 - 2nd round: Tuesday 12 May 2026 at 12 noon CEST
4. Add housing@au.dk as safe sender
5. Receive weekly status emails to keep you updated on your housing application
6. Receive an email from AU Housing in May (before 1 June)
7. Accept the housing offer by making an online payment within 48 hours

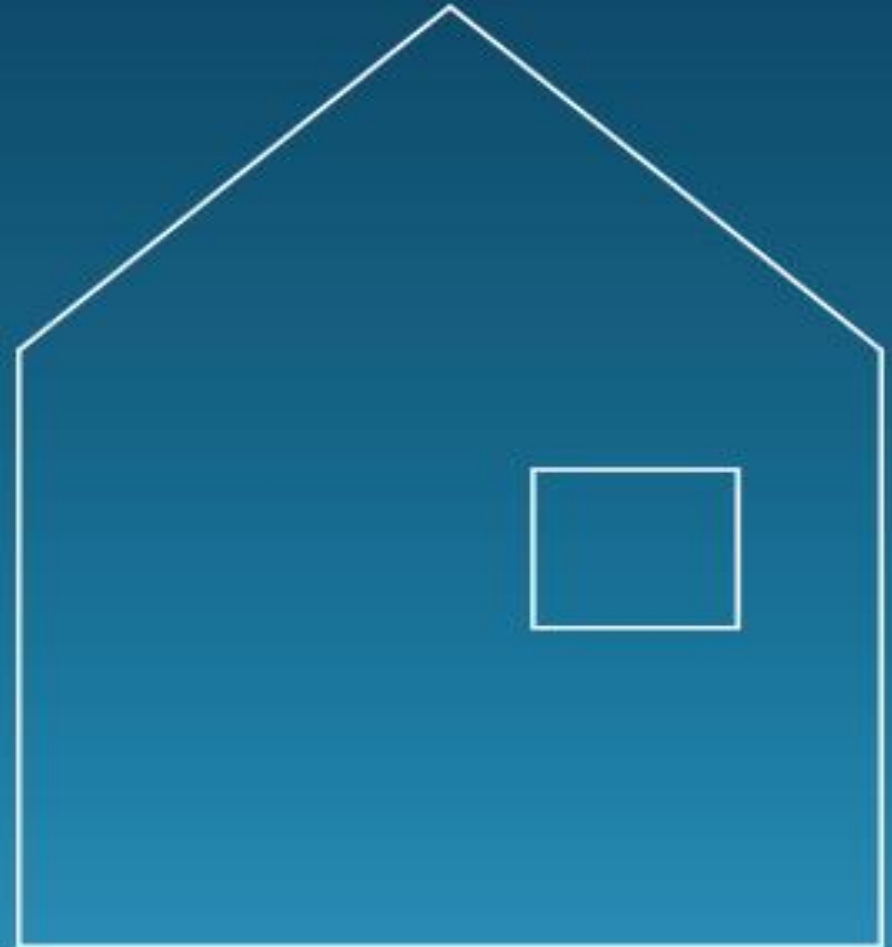
