

Call for applications for funding of research stay at Health

This call is with the purpose of furthering the internationalization of the PhD education at Health. The call is funded by Aarhus University Research Foundation, and is subject to sufficient funds.

Purpose

There are two different options under this call:

1. Recruitment of talented international researchers to PhD programs at Health

DKK 10,000 for 1-3 months plus max. DKK 10,000 in travel expenses as funding for a research stay at Health. The grant is awarded to potential PhD students with a qualifying degree from a Non-Danish university. The purpose of the research stay is an assessment of the candidate's suitability for PhD studies at Health, and the stay can thus be used for preparing an application for PhD enrolment and a general introduction to the local research environment.

2. A term of research at Health for international PhD students

DKK 10,000 for 3-6 months plus max. DKK 10,000 in travel expenses as funding for a research stay at Health. The grant is awarded to international PhD students enrolled at a Non-Danish university. The purpose of the research stay is PhD studies and project work relevant to the candidate's PhD program.

Available funding

The grant consists of a scholarship of DKK 10,000 per month to be used for living expenses including housing, course fees etc., and up to DKK 10,000 for travel expenses including visa etc. The grant cannot be used for project materials and permanent equipment or for travel expenses for family members.

The scholarship is not to be compared with a salaried position and is not extended due to maternity or paternity leave or sickness. It does not include holiday allowance or pension, and the candidate will not be covered by AU insurance schemes.

Please allow funding and time for settling in and acquiring any necessary documents between arrival in Denmark and the first month of the project.

The research stay must be concluded by the end of 2015.

How to apply

The applicant is the contact or co-supervisor at Health, who must be an employee at Health. Please use the appropriate application form found on our website. Applications are mailed to <u>th@sun.au.dk</u> (International Advisor Tanja Hansen) no later than May 19, 2014.

A decision as to who are offered a scholarship can be expected in June 2014.
