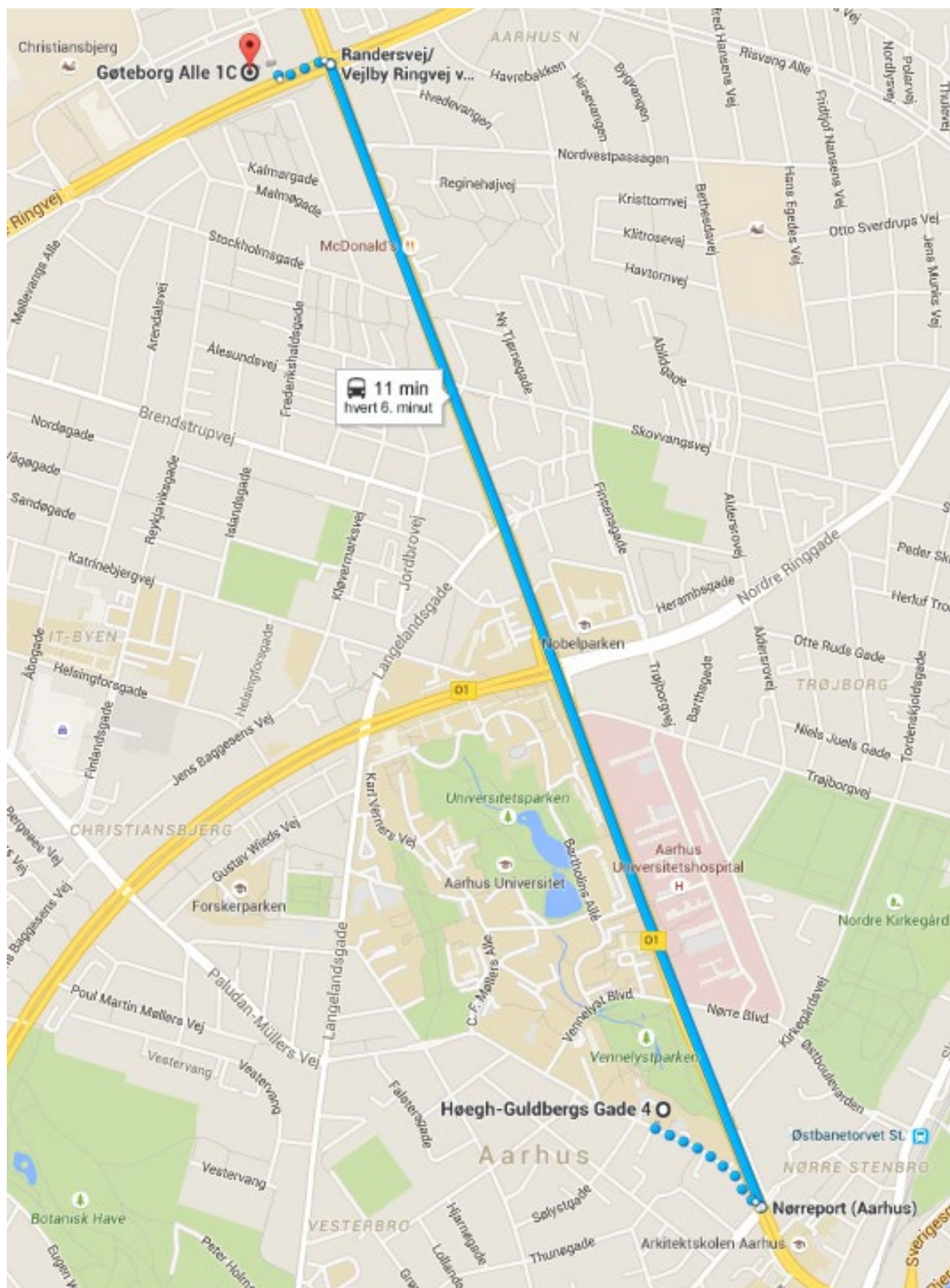


Going from the International Centre to Christianshøj and Christiansbjerg (Gøteborg Allé 1c & 3)

When you walk out of International Centre turn left. Turn left again on Høegh-Guldbergs Gade. Walk down Høegh-Guldbergs Gade. When you reach the end of Høegh-Guldbergs Gade, cross Nørrebrogade (the big road) and go to the bus stop on Nørrebrogade. This bus stop is called **Nørreport**.



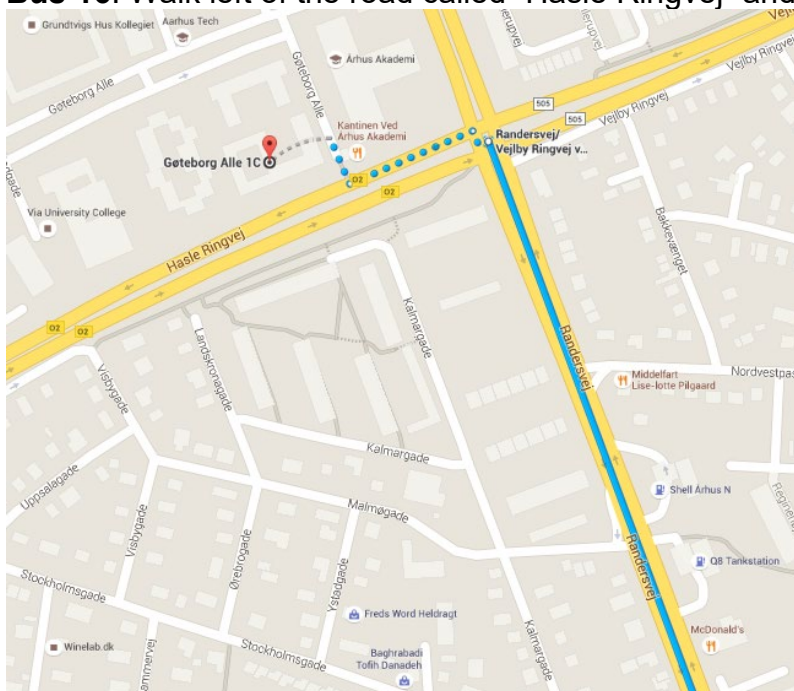
Bus 16 and 200 or Letbanen (direction L2)

Take bus 16, 200 or Letbanen (L2) heading north. Get off at the bus stop called “Randersvej/vandtårnet (16)” or if taking Letbanen: “Nehrus Allé.” Ask the bus driver to tell you when you reach the bus stop of “Randersvej/vandtårnet (16) or Nydamsvej/Randersvej (200)”. In Letbanen and most of the buses there will be a speaker announcing the stop and a digital sign showing it.

Bus 16: Walk left of the road called “Hasle Ringvej” and turn at “Gøteborg Allé”:



Here is a translation of the Danish days mentioned in the bus schedules:

Hverdage undt. lørdage = *Weekdays except Saturdays*

Mandag – Fredag = *Monday - Friday*

Lørdage = *Saturdays*

Søndage = *Sundays*
