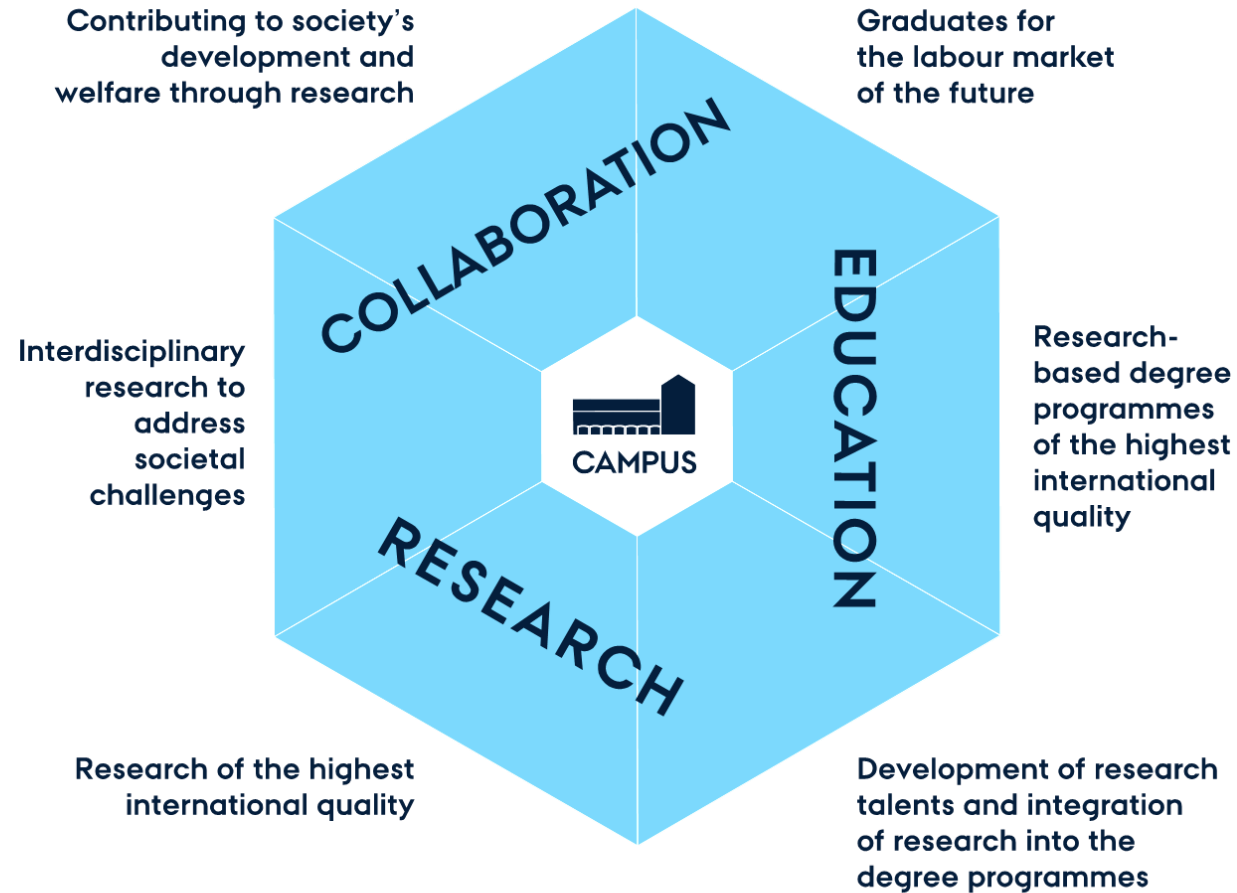

These ambitious goals live up to the Paris Agreement and the Danish government's goal of reducing carbon emissions by 70% in 2030 against a 1990 baseline.

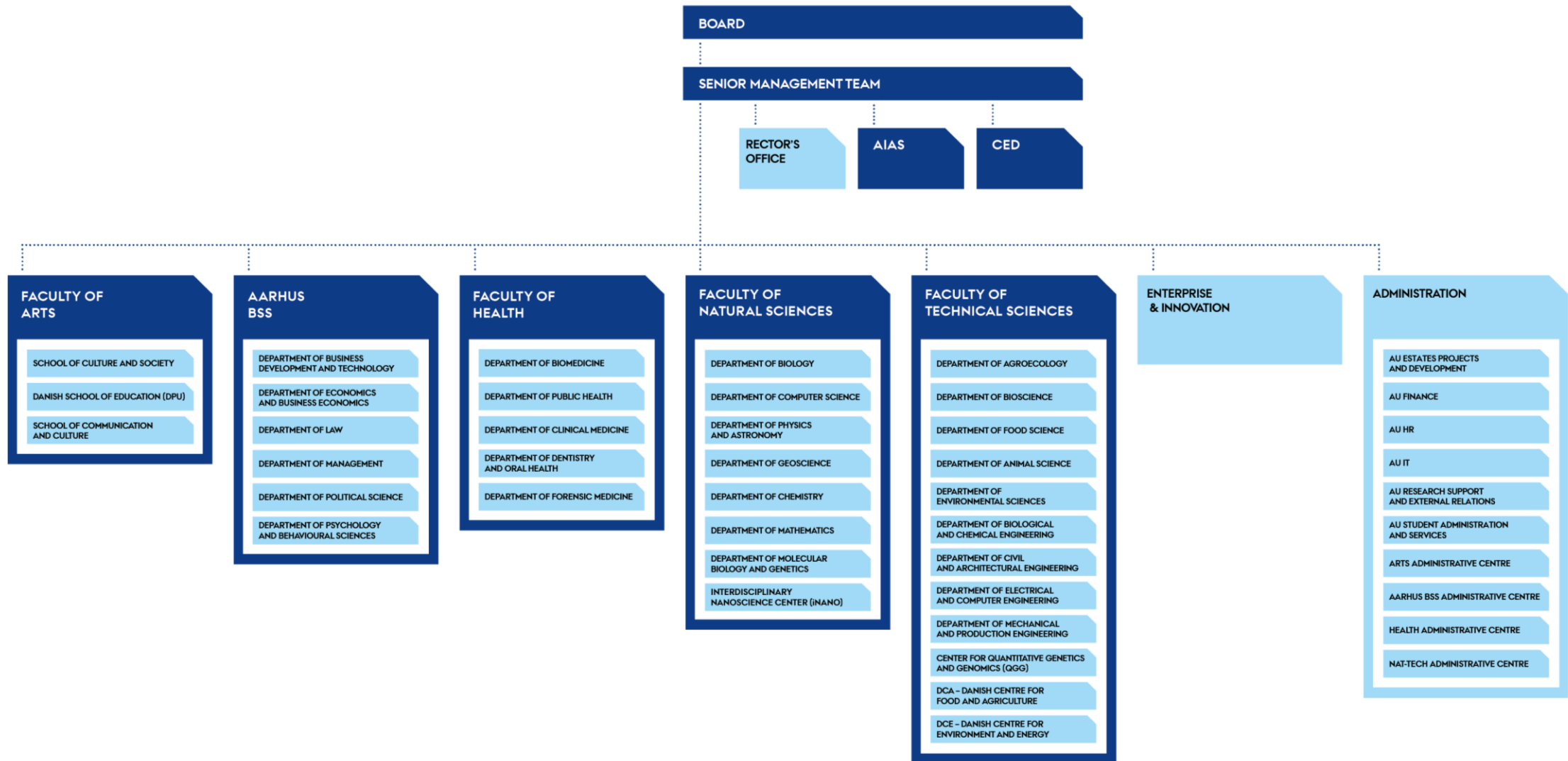

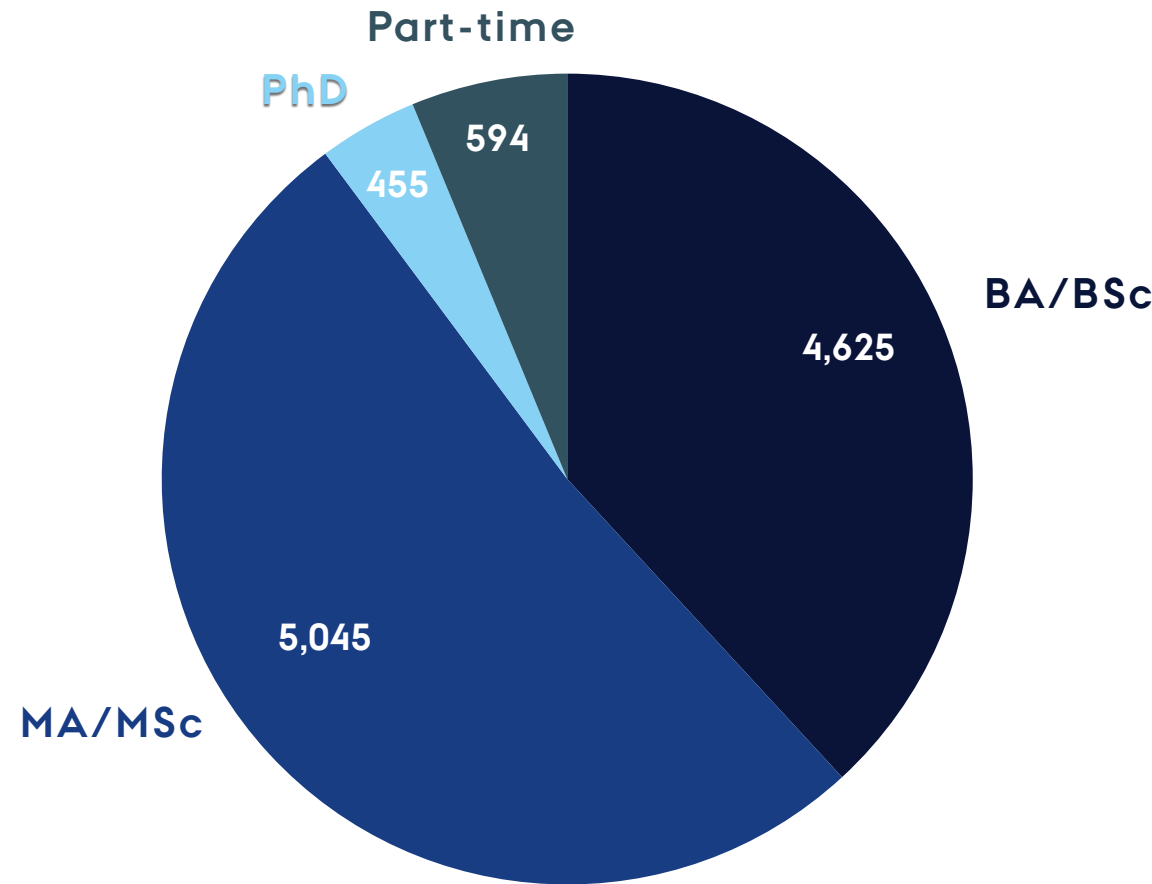

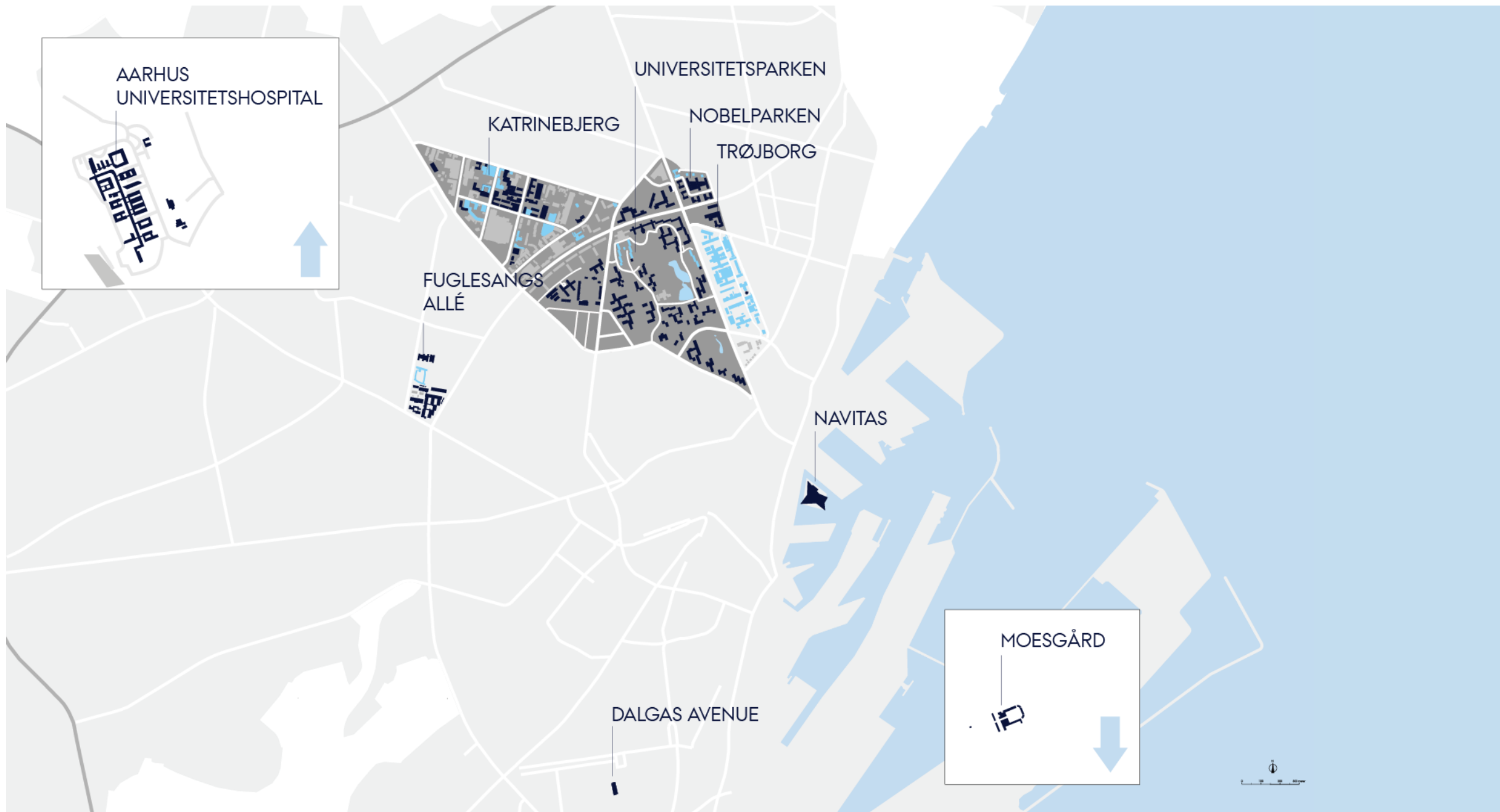

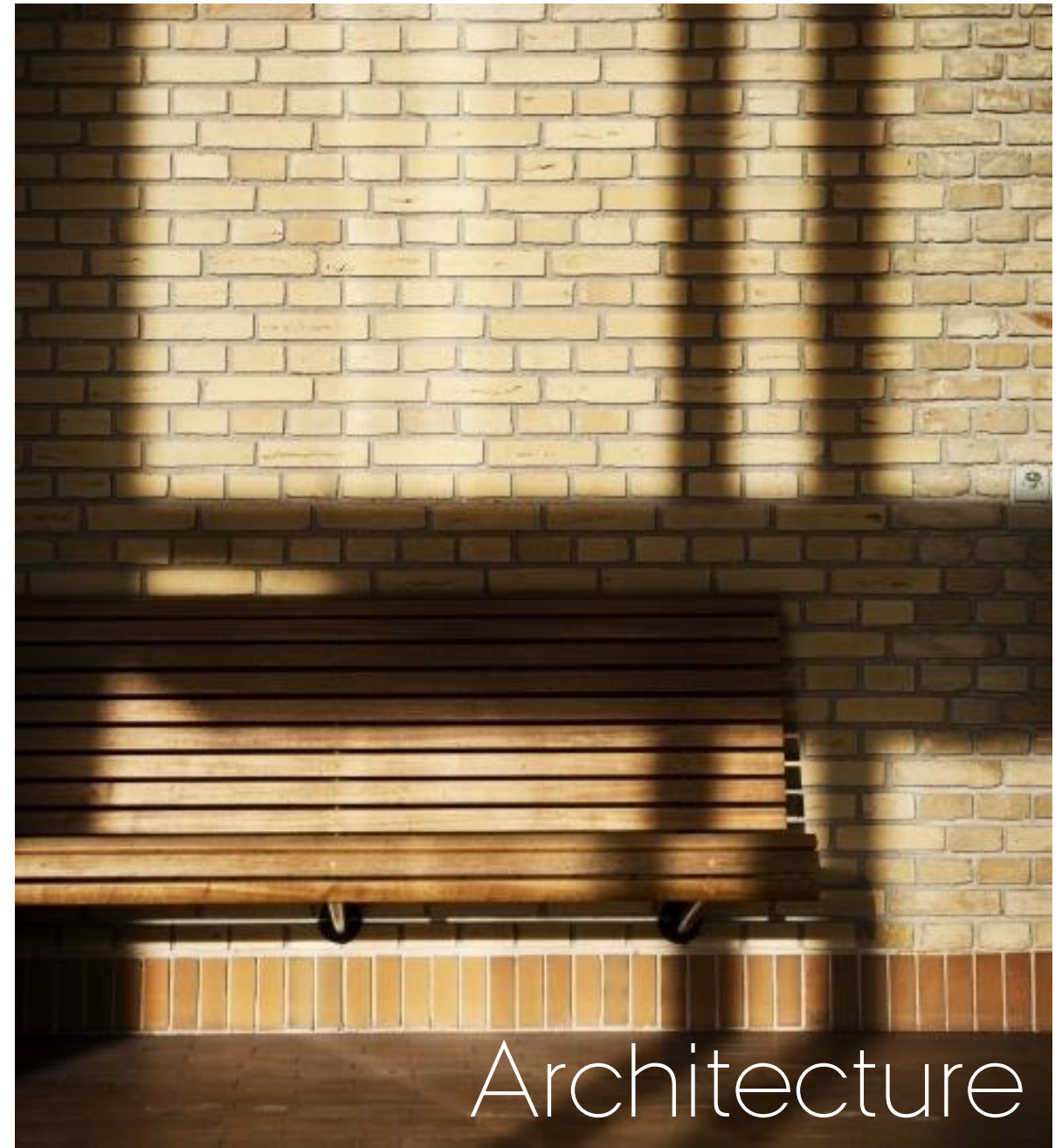
