

# KITCHEN RULES

All the things in the kitchen are for you to use, but please handle it with care.

- o Please remember to turn off any electrical devices (the oven, the kettle etc), when you are done using it.
- o The tables have to be cleaned after every use.
  - Use "sulfo" or "opvaskemiddel" to clean the tabletop, rinse it with water and dry it with a dish towel.
  - You have to remove any water and so from the tabletop.
  - DO NOT put any hot pots or pans on the tabletops. Use instead the trivets.
  - DO NOT use wire wool ("stålsvamp"). It will damage the tabletop.

## When you are done cooking

When you are done cooking, please clean up after yourself.

- o This includes washing up the things you have used, cleaning the tabletop etc.
- Do not leave things to dry themselves. Wipe the clean dishes with the dishtowel until it is dry and put it back to its place. It is important that it is totally dry. Do not place wet items in the cupboards.
- o Clean the oven, microwave and range hood after use. (each time)
- o The detergent used for washing up dishes is called "sulfo" or "opvaskemiddel".

#### Rubbish

Place rubbish in the rubbish bin. Always make sure there is a black plastic bag in the rubbish bin. You need to buy plastic bags yourself. **Empty the rubbish bin every day**. Close the plastic bag, and place it in the green container outside the back entrance door. Please don't place rubbish elsewhere.

#### The refrigerator

Room 212-219/312-319: Use refrigerator no. 1 (the one closest to the door) Room 220-226/320-326 and 414, 424: Use refrigerator no. 2 (not the one closest to the door)

#### The freezer

You find two freezers in the laundry room. You need to mark all items with your name and room number. All unmarked items will be removed. Please remember to remove everything when you move out.

### In general

- Cleaning products are provided by the housing office, these items can be found in the cupboard in the kitchen.
