


SETTING UP NETWORK IN MAC OSX

1. First, select settings for **Network (NETVÆRK)** which can be found in the control panel/system preferences.




2. Select **Ethernet (INDBYGGET ETHERNET)** and click **Configure (KONFIGURER)**. If you also have a network at home, it might be a good idea to create a new location so you can easily switch between network settings.



3. Click **TCP/IP**, in the dropdown menu select **DHCP**. It might be an advantage to add a DNS server to increase the stability of the network. Under **DNS**, add these IP-adresses:

4. Then select **Apply** and **Save (ANVEND, OG GEM)**
