

SETTING UP NETWORK IN WINDOWS XP

STEP 1

1. Open **Network Connections (NETVÆRKSFORBINDELSER)**. Which can be found in the Control Panel or in the menu as shown in Figure 1.

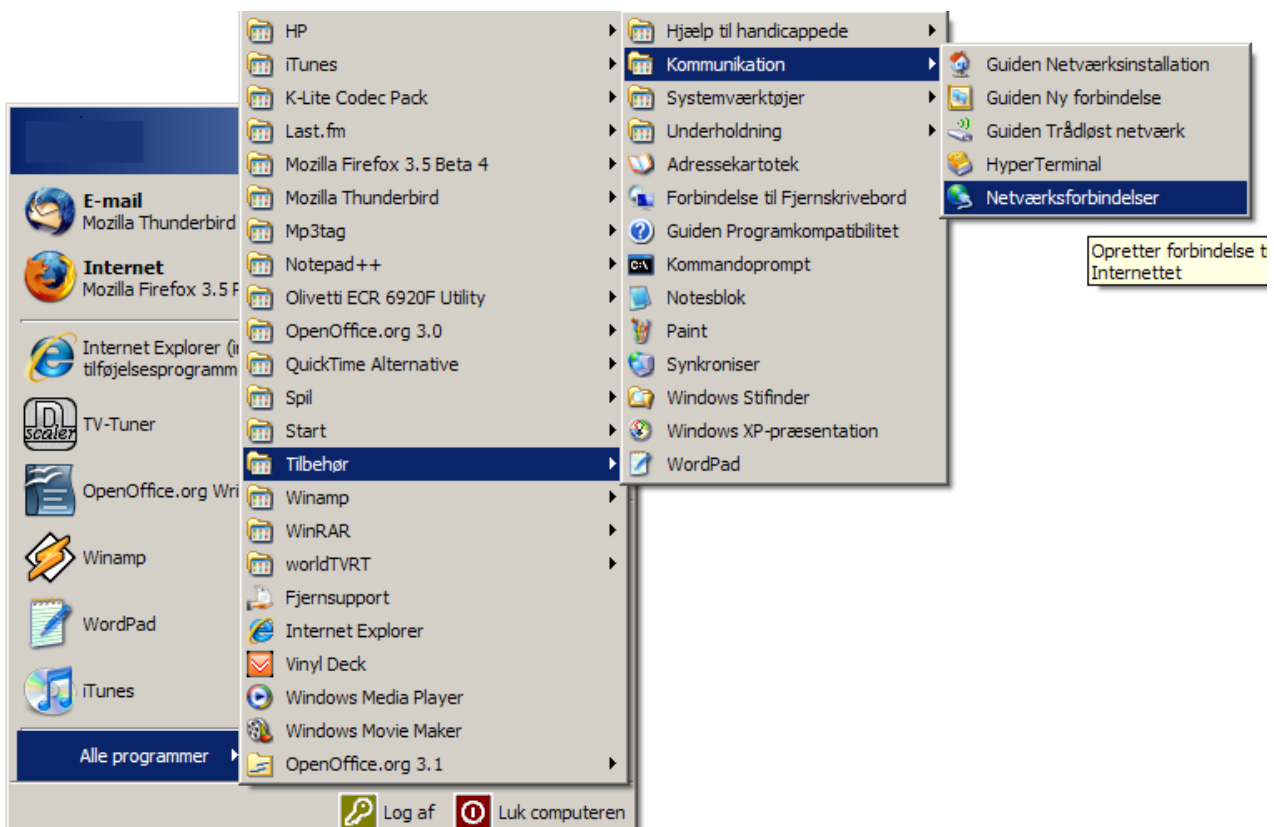

STEP 2

1. Find the network connection your ethernet cable is plugged into. Usually, it will be the only connection with the icon as shown in figure 2. If there is a connection called **1394-FORBINDELSE**, this must *not* be used.
2. Open settings for the network connection by right-clicking it and selecting **Properties (EGENSKABER)**.

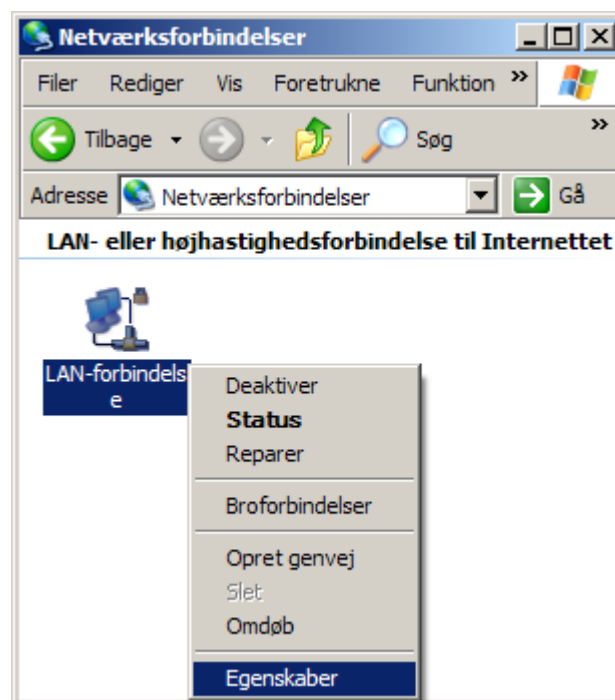
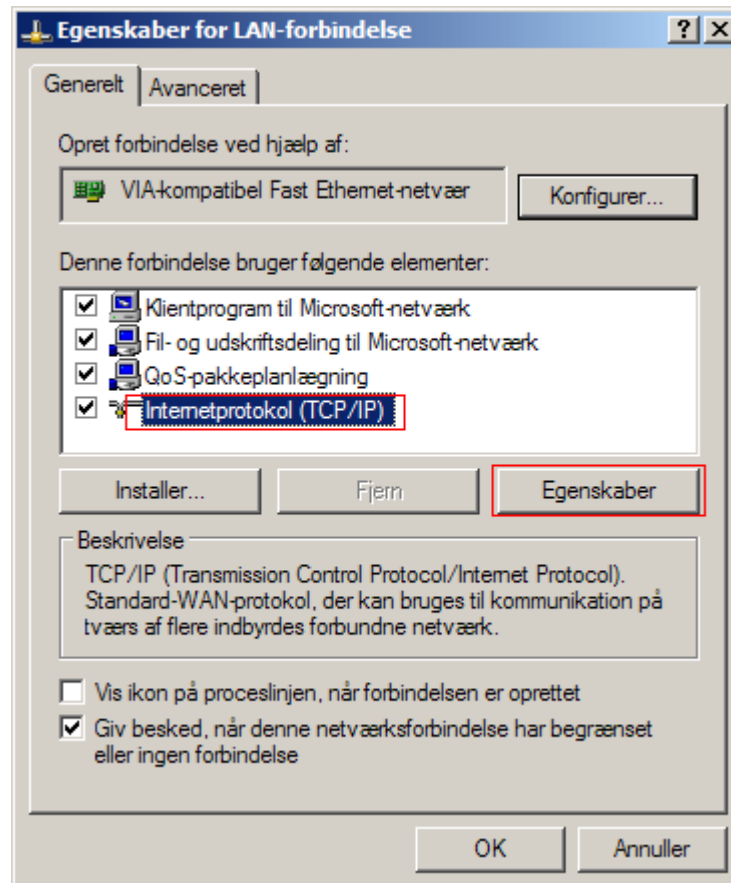

STEP 3

1. Find **INTERNETPROTOKOL (TCP/IP)** and select it.
2. Select **Properties (EGENSKABER)**.

STEP 4

1. Select **Obtain an IP address automatically (HENT AUTOMATISK EN IP-ADRESSE)**.
2. Select **Obtain DNS server address automatically (HENT AUTOMATISK EN DNS-SERVERADRESSE)**. Though, it is an advantage to use alternative DNS-services (like OpenDNS) as it can provide more stability for the internet connection. The alternative DNS-setup is shown in Figure 4.
3. Select **OK**.

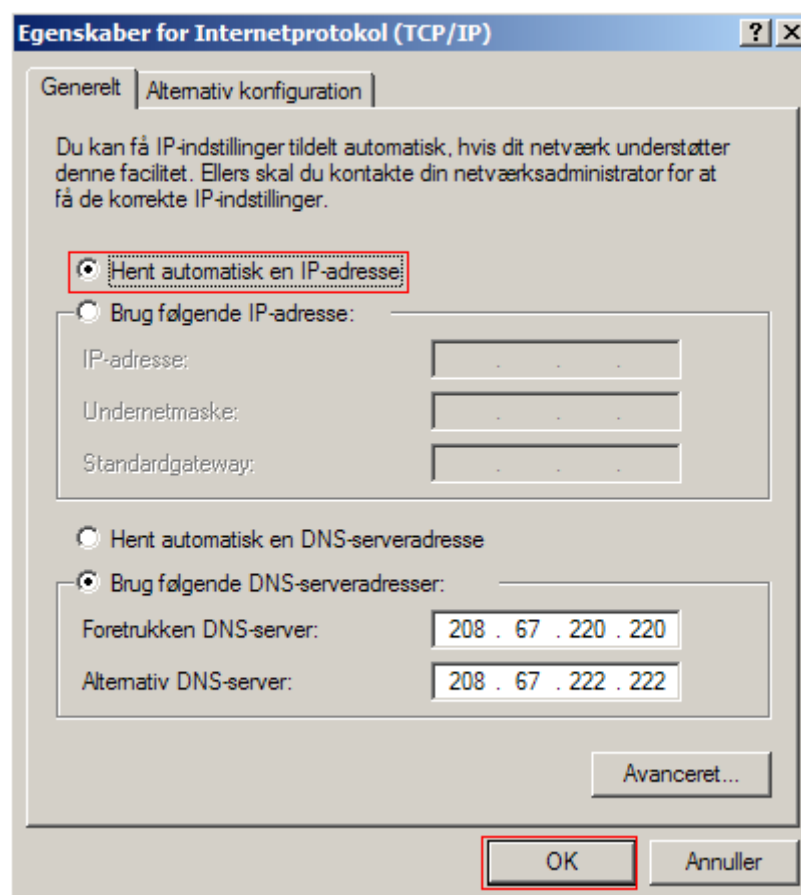
