The main bus company in Aarhus is called **Midttrafik**. There are multiple ways for you to get information and buy tickets.

# How often do you need to go by bus?

#### 5 or more return travels weekly

A **Periodekort** (season pass) is your best choice. With this card you can travel within the zones 301 - 303 for 30 days at the price of 380 DKK.

Price: 380 DKK for 30 days

## 3-4 return travels weekly

A **Rejsekort** (travel card) is your best choice. An electronic ticketing system for travelling by bus and train.

Check in with your card at the start of your journey and check out at the end of your journey. The price for each travel will be calculated automatically and deducted from your preloaded card. **Order it online** or at Aarhus H (railway station) and find more information on prices at: www.rejsekort.dk/en

Price: Cardfee - 50 DKK
Preload your card with fx. 200
DKK and travel until you have spent the amount.

## 1-2 return travels weekly or less

A **Klippekort** (multiride ticket valid for 10 bus rides) is your best choice. Last for 2 hours and 15 minutes. MUST be bought before getting on the bus.

Buy it through the **Midttrafik App**.

A **Single Ticket** is the most expensive option but is for the ones who travel very few times. Can be bought both on the app and with cash on the bus.

Price: 170 DKK for 10 bus rides for 2 zones
