To access Eduroam, you need to install it on your devices: Smartphone, tablet and laptop. You can easily do this at home.

Guide:

- Log on another network. At AU, you can use the AU Guest network.
- Run the programme, 'eduroam installer', from cat.eduroam.org
- Your user name is `au<AUID>@uni.au.dk` (ex: `au123456@uni.au.dk`)
(Your AU ID is the six-digit number to the right of your name at `mit.au.dk`)
- Use the same password that you use for `mit.au.dk` or your AU webmail
